

## **Protest in Gries am Brenner Confirmed: temporary traffic closure along the Brenner corridor on May 30, 2026**

Dear guest,

on **Saturday, May 30, 2026** a demonstration is scheduled in **Gries am Brenner**, Austria, which will cause a temporary traffic closure along the Brenner corridor.

Given that this coincides with a period of particularly heavy traffic along the Brenner corridor—between the return from the Pentecost holidays and departures for the June 2 long weekend—traffic delays or disruptions cannot be ruled out even on the days immediately preceding and following the closure.

From 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., the **A13 Brenner** motorway will be closed in both directions between the **Brenner state border and the Schönberg main toll station**. The same measure will also affect the B182 Brenner federal road on the Austrian side. For this reason, the A22 Brenner motorway will also be closed northbound from **Vipiteno/Sterzing between 10:30 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.**. In case of heavy traffic or long queues, the closure may be extended as far as **Bressanone/Brixen, Chiusa/Klausen or Bolzano/Bozen**.

If you have planned to depart during those days or need to travel, we recommend that you check your route in advance and, if possible, consider leaving well before or after the time slot affected by the closure, or consider alternative routes such as the Timmelsjoch Pass, the Resia Pass, or the route via Tarvisio.
